Lab 2A: Creating an Answer File by Using the Setup Manager Wizard



After completing this lab, you will be able to:

- Install the Setup Manager Wizard.
- Create an answer file by using the Setup Manager Wizard.

Prerequisites

Before working on this lab, you must have:

- Completed Lab 1C Upgrading Windows 98 to Windows XP Professional.
- Knowledge of Microsoft® Windows® XP Professional Setup.
- Knowledge of Windows XP Professional unattended setup parameters.

Lab Setup

A computer running Microsoft Windows XP Professional.

Scenario

You are supporting the marketing division in your organization. The marketing division has just purchased portable computers for each of the marketing representatives, and you have to install Windows XP Professional on each of the computers. To speed up the installation process, you need to automate the installation process.

Estimated time to complete this lab: 30 minutes

Exercise 1 Creating an Answer File

Scenario

As the lead of the Windows XP Professional deployment team in your organization, you need to design an answer file to install Windows XP Professional from a compact disc. The answer file should produce an installation that meets the following criteria:

- Setup must be a fully automated CD-ROM installation.
- The default user name must be Trader, and the organization name must be NWTraders.
- The computer names must be assigned.
- The local Administrator account must be protected with a password of **password**.
- The display resolution on all client computers must be set to 800×600.
- The time zone must be set appropriately.
- Disk Defragmenter (Dfrg.msc) must run the first time that a user logs on.
- The answer file must be named Unattend.txt and be saved in the C:\Deploy folder.

Note For the purposes of this lab, you use Disk Defragmenter to demonstrate how to specify that a program run at first logon. Normally, you would not run Disk Defragmenter on a recently formatted hard disk.

Goal

In this exercise, you will install the Setup Manager Wizard and then create an answer file to produce an automated installation that meets the set of specified criteria.

Tasks	Detailed Steps
1. Log on to the local computer as Administrator, with a password of password. Create a folder, and name the folder Deploy. Extract the files from Deploy.cab to the Deploy folder.	 a. Log on to the local computer as Administrator with a password of password.
	 Insert the Windows XP Professional compact disc into the CD-ROM drive, and then click Exit to close the Microsoft Windows XP Professional CD screen.
	c. Click Start, and then click Run.
	d. In the Open box, type CD-ROM\support\tools\deploy.cab (where CD-ROM is the drive letter assigned to your CD-ROM drive), and then click OK.
	e. In the Deploy window, select all of the files, right-click any selected file, and then click Extract .
	 In the Select a Destination window, expand My Computer, click Local Disk (C:) and then click Make a New Folder.
	g. Rename new folder to Deploy, and then click Extract.
	h. Close the Deploy window.
2. Create the Unattend.txt file to meet the criteria specified in the scenario. Output Description:	a. In Windows Explorer, move to the C:\Deploy folder, and then in the details pane, double-click setupmgr.
	 b. On the Welcome to the Windows XP Professional Setup Manager Wizard page, click Next.
	c. On the New or Existing Answer File page, verify that Create a new answer file is selected, and then click Next.
	d. On the Product to Install page, verify that Windows XP Unattended Installation is selected, and then click Next.
	 e. On the Platform page, verify that Windows XP Professional is selected, and then click Next.
	f. On the User Interaction Level page, click Fully automated, and then click Next.
	g. On the Distribution Folder page, click No, this answer file will be used to install from a CD, and then click Next.
	h. On the License Agreement page, select the I accept the terms of the License Agreement check box, and then click Next.
	 i. On the Customize the Software page, in the Name box, type Your_Name, in the Organization box, type NWTraders and then click Next
	 j. On the Display Settings page, in the Screen area box, click 800 X 600, and then click Next.
	 k. On the Time Zone page, select your current time zone, and then click Next.

Tasks	Detailed Steps
2. (continued)	On the Providing CD Key page, enter the CD Key, and then click Next.
	m. On the Computer Names page, in the Computer Name box, type the name of your computer, click Add, and then click Next.
	n. On the Administrator Password page, in the Password and Confirm password boxes, type password, select the Encrypt administrator password in answer file check box, and then click Next. On the Networking Components page, verify Typical settings is selected, and then click Next.
	o. On the Workgroup or Domain page, select Windows Server domain, and the name is nwtraders.msft, click Create a computer account in the domain, type Administrator for the User name, type password for the Password and Confirm password, and then click Next.
	 p. Accept the default settings on the Telephony, Regional Settings, Languages, Browser and Shell Settings, Installation Folder, and Install Printers pages.
	q. On the Run Once page, in the Command to run box, type dfrg.msc click Add, and then click Next.
	r. On the Additional Commands page, click Finish.
	s. In the Location and file name box, verify that C:\Deploy\Unattend.txt appears, and then click OK.
	t. Close the Setup Manager Wizard.
	u. Close all open windows, and log off.
